Instead of selecting an organization, you will be asked to enter their **username** or **email address**.

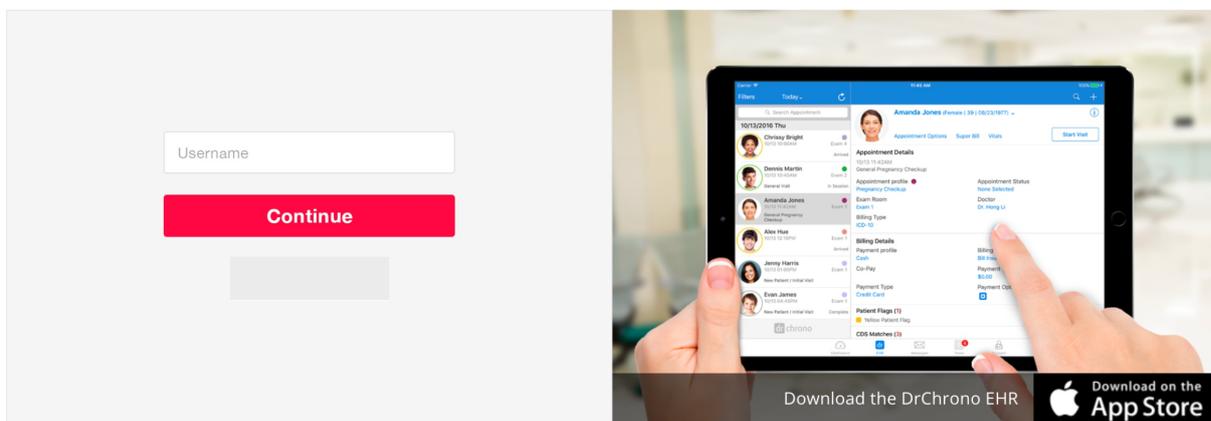

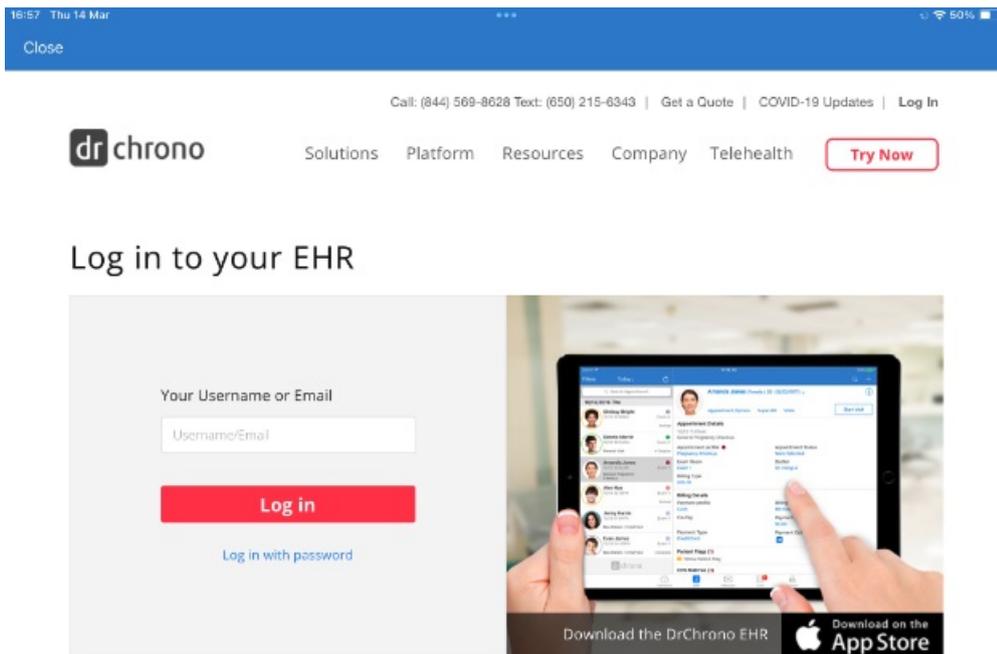
## Mobile

The new SSO login workflow is also available on the mobile EHR app. As with the web, all users will see the login screen below.

Users without SSO enabled will log in with their usernames and passwords as usual. Users with SSO enabled can log in with their username and password or select **Log in with SSO(Beta)**.



If you select Log in with SSO(Beta), you will be taken to the DrChrono webpage, where you will enter your username and password, as seen below.



Once you click the **Log In** button, you will be prompted to sign in with your Google Account (as an example of an Identity Provider) or your Identity Provider of choice.
