


• Click on the 3 horizontal dots on the right and select Duplicate.



Duplicate the estimate?

• The system will give you a pop-up asking if you want to duplicate the estimate.





• When you click on **OK**, the system will duplicate the estimate and place it in the patient's listing, placing the new/duplicated estimate on top.
