Here's how:

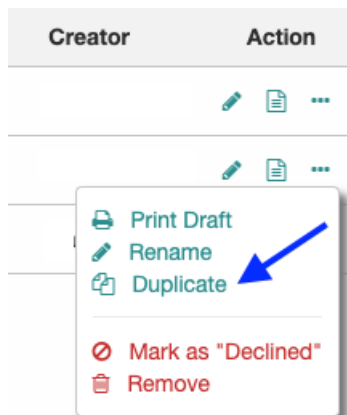
- Navigate to the patient's chart and locate the declined estimate.

- Click on the 3 horizontal dots on the right and select **Duplicate**.



- The system will give you a pop-up asking if you want to duplicate the estimate.

- When you click on **OK**, the system will duplicate the estimate and place it in the patient's listing, placing the new/duplicated estimate on top.
