A point of origin code discloses to the payer the source or method of the patient's referral for admission. The point of origin code is similar to a "place of service" code on a professional claim/HCFA-1500 form.

To add it to an institutional claim/UB04/HCFA 1450 institutional form, navigate to Billing > Live Claims Feed > Inside patient's appointment > right side of the screen > Info tab
