

UB04 Box 26 - Utilizing a claim ID from a claim form


Each patient appointment within DrChrono will be assigned a unique claim ID number automatically. This number will be transmitted to the payer with each submitted claim.

On the **HCFA-1500 form**, it will print in box 26 under the label "Patient's Account No.". The first 6 digits will be your client group account number with DrChrono and the following 9 digits are the patient's claim ID/account number.

- **Blue box** - The first 6 digits are your DrChrono client group account number
- **Green box** - The last 9 digits are your patient's claim ID/account number



The patient's claim id/account number can be entered into the box labeled "drc claim #" in your Live Claims Feed. It will pull up the patient and the exact date of service.
