How do I hide medications and allergies from the clinical note?

By default, the medications and allergies will appear on the clinical note. There are two options to hide them from the completed note: individually or all notes.

Hiding medications and allergies from an individual note

1. Open a clinical note, and click on the H&P or the SOAP tab. Next, click on the Medications & Allergies tab.
