Importing and Merging Data for a C-CDA for an Individual Patient

You can import a C-CDA (Consolidated Clinical Document Architecture) to a patient's chart. Once uploaded, you can reconcile their medications, problems, and allergies.

1. Go to the patient's chart and select the Clinical Dashboard.

point, you can select Back to Clinical Dashboard to return to the patient's clinical dashboard.

Click Confirm to import the selected problems. Clicking Preview Finalized Problems allows you to see a complete list of the patient's problems with both previous and newly added problems.
