

Setting Up ConnectEHR for FHIR

Starting with the 2023 MIPS Promoting Interoperability reporting period, in order to meet the 2023 [Provide Patient Access Promoting Interoperability](#) measure, your practice must implement our new ONC Cures Edition FHIR. To get started you need to set up the [ConnectEHR](#) for FHIR.

If you need to report for MIPS, you can set up your FHIR APIs in order to report. If you do not need to report for MIPS, it is not necessary for you to set up the FHIR APIs.



Set Up

In order to access the Connect EHR for FHIR API screen, click on **Account** and select **API**.
