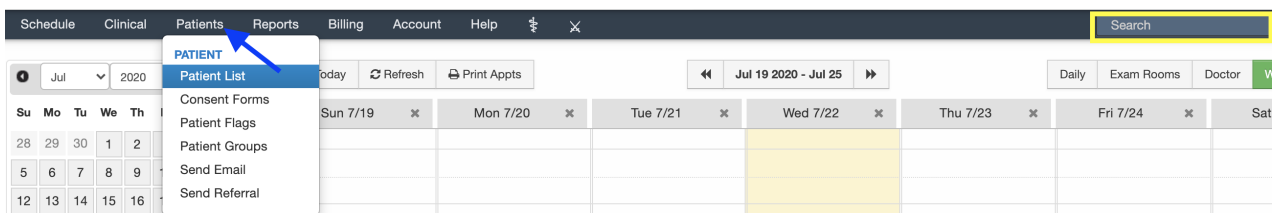


# Tracking Your Patient Problems with the Patient Problem List

The Patient Problem List is a convenient way to keep track of your patient's diagnoses. With the patient problem list, you can keep track of both active and inactive problems with a patient and have the problems [auto-populated onto your appointments](#).

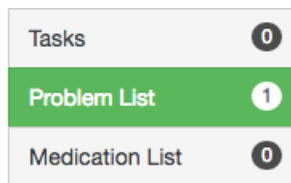
1. Go to **Patients > Patient List** or enter a patient's name or chart ID in the **Search** field in the top right. (If you use **Search**, it will take you to the patient's chart and you can go to step 3).



2. In the **Patient List**, click on the chart ID of the patient you would like to make inactive.

3. Once in the patient's chart, on the left-hand navigation bar, select **Problem List**.



You'll be presented with the patient's Patient Problem List. Here you can view all of the patient's active problems, the codes associated with the problems, the medical terminology code (SNOMED), diagnosis date, change date, active status, and notes.

Select a problem from the search results and your ICD code and SNOMED CT code will be auto-populated. Fill out the rest of the form and select **Save** when complete.
