
## Signing and Locking a Clinical Note on the iPhone



To sign a note in the EHR/EMR app on your iPhone, you need to have started a visit and filled out the H&P/SOAP or Additional forms for a patient.

After all your clinical notes have been filled out, select **View Complete Note** at the bottom of the page. Read over your note to verify its contents.



Next, select **Sign & Lock** at the top of the screen.



The note will have an e-signature with a time and date stamp at the bottom.
