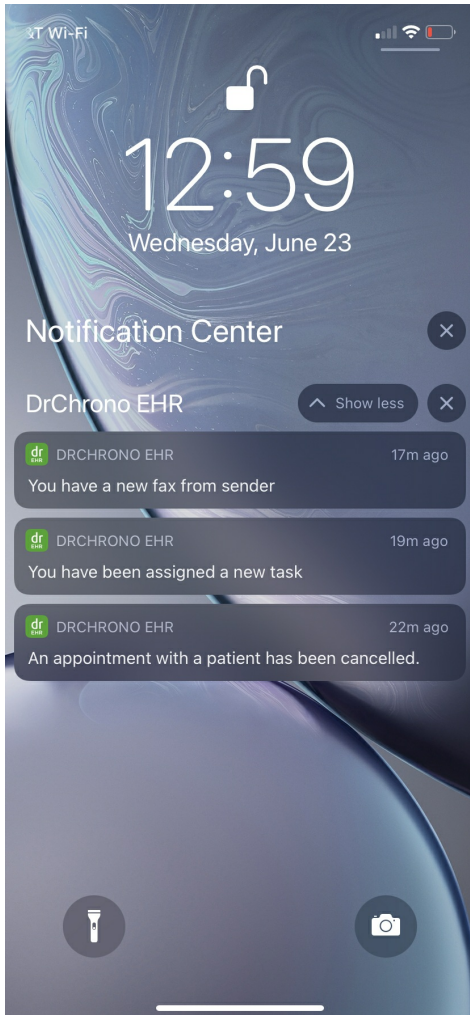


Push Notifications for iPhone

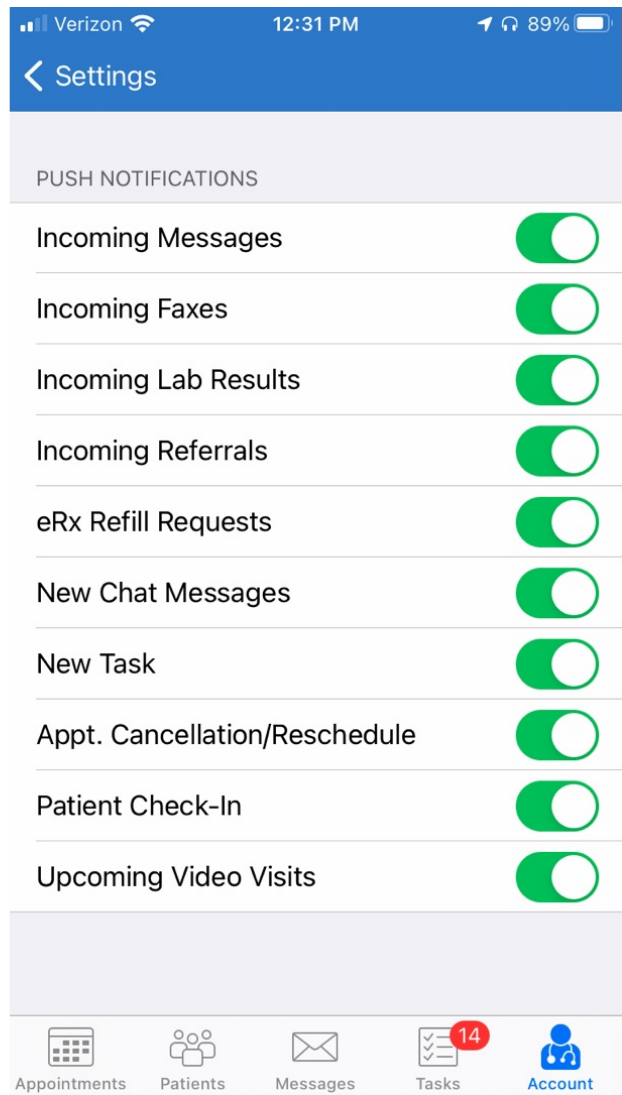
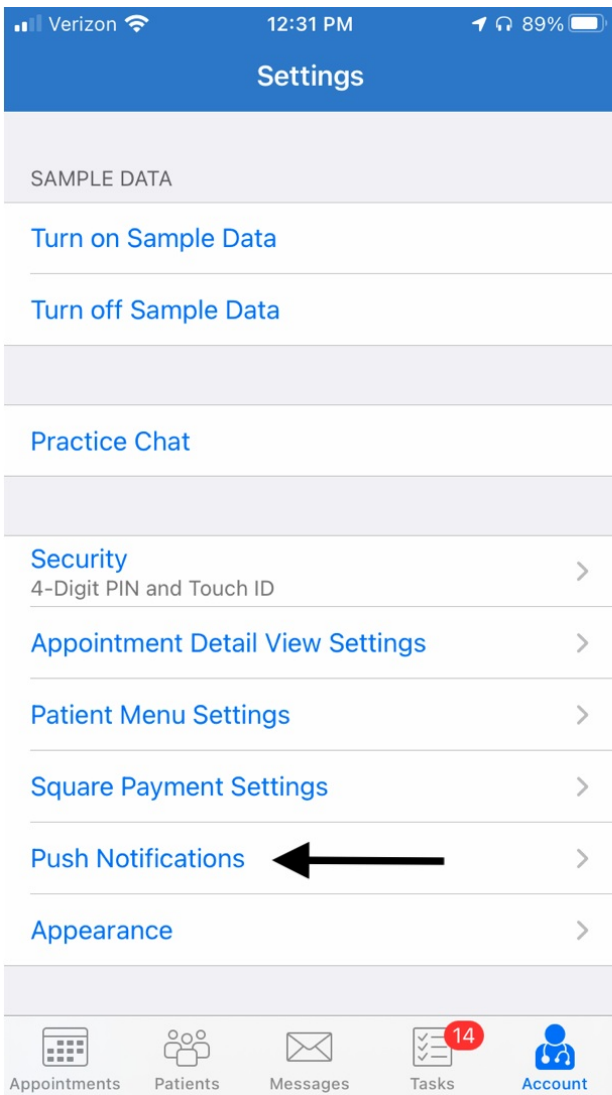
3. Select **Push Notifications**. Choose the notifications you would like to receive by turning on or off with the switches (



/

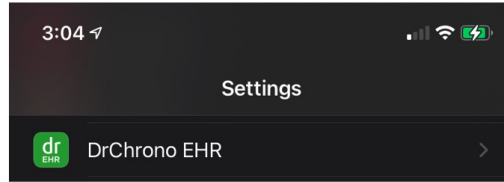
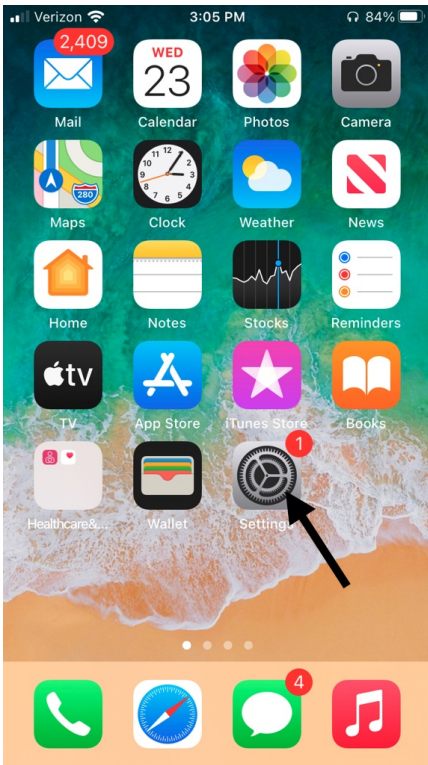
